To ensure uniformity of contents ULSIT will deliver templates and short guidelines for the development of the contents, incl. number of pages/slides for the theoretical contents, number of questions in the quiz, type of questions, number of resources, etc. The deadline for this task is **28th March 2025**.

Once the guidelines have been communicated to partners, they will start with the development of the contents. Partners will again check the sub-topics listed in the [common document](#) to see if there is any overlap between topics.

The partners will coordinate the work on their topics within the assigned teams. If needed, bilateral meetings may be organized to distribute tasks and deadlines. It was decided that every team will deliver **1 prototype on one sub-topic prior to the next online meeting** (28th April, 14:00 CET) to check with ULSIT if they are on the right path of delivery. Any arising questions/issues will be discussed during the next online meeting.

The deadline for delivery of all contents in English (as stated in the project application form) is 30th June 2025. However, more specific deadlines will be communicated to the partners by ULSIT in the guidelines for content creation.
